

Set-up:

- 1) Draw the Sun in the correct position (relative to Moon/Earth)
- 2) Using arrows, identify the orbit of the moon around the Earth.

Procedure:

- 1) Identify, label and draw (view from Earth) the Full Moon and New Moon in the corresponding locations.
- 2) Using the arrows: identify, label, and draw (view from Earth) each moon phase in the corresponding locations.

\*Explain: why are the moons and Earth "half shaded."
